The Implementation of REACH requires the registration of chemical substances. These registrations are based on submission of data. To fulfill the testing requirements under REACH, physico-chemical, human health and environmental property studies have to be performed. Estimations suggest the following average costs per substance:

> 1 t and < 10 t:	20.000 €
> 10 t and < 100 t:	200.000 €
> 100 t and < 1.000 t:	600.000 €
> 1.000 t:	1.200.000 €

Consequently, data becomes a valuable asset.

Up until now studies have been used for registration and notification purposes and disappeared thereafter in the archives. Data even remained there when product lines have been divested or manufacturing of chemicals ceased. Today many companies might have undiscovered values in their archives.
